

Food Matters Wine List 2017

Sparkling Wines and Champagne:

Prosecco Spumante Colli Trevigiani NV, Enrico Bedin, Veneto, Italy £16.75

This wonderfully pretty Prosecco is so beautifully balanced and fresh, with flavours of ripe apple and a very subtle grapiness leading to a really crystal clean finish.

A. Laurence Brut NV, Loire Valley, France £16.75

Clean, crisp aromas of fresh apple, followed by citrus fruit and pears. Complemented by a gentle fizz and a lingering fruit driven finish.

Champagne Gaston Dericbourg NV, Cuvee de Reserve Brut, France £37.50

Fabulously traditional style with gentle biscuit flavours complemented by deliciously refined, grapey fruit flavours. A fantastically quaffable Champagne to be matched with canapés.

Champagne André Roger Grand Cru NV, Tradition, Ay, France £49.00

Powerful aromas of fruits in pastry, stewed apricot with notes of sugared almond. The feel in the mouth is very ample and long, with pastry flavours and ending on a spicy note.

White Wines:

Goleta Sauvignon Blanc 2016, Central Valley, Chile £12.00

The wine displays aromas of capsicum and citrus fruits aromas with zippy and fresh, ripe citrus. Coupled with green apple flavour that is delectably moreish.

Galassia Garganega Pinot Grigio 2016, Veneto, Italy £12.50

Light, fresh and easy drinking white from Italy, with crisp lemon citrus and pears. A crisp finish to complete this excellent wine.

Moulin des Vignes Chardonnay 2015, Pays d'Oc, France £13.25

Bright gold in colour and displays aromas of quince, honey and sweet spice. Combined with notes of fresh citrus and white peach flavours and a rounded finish.

The War Horse Chenin Blanc 2016, Stellenbosch, South Africa £13.50

Sensational, explosively refreshing and cleansing Chenin with a wonderful sun kissed apple flavour. It's perfect to be enjoyed with fish dishes and salads.

Maison de la Paix Viognier 2015, Pays d'Oc, France **£15.50**

This Viognier from the South of France is lovely and clean with delicious peach and apricot flavours

Vaquero Unwooded Chardonnay 2014, Lodi, California, USA **£15.50**

Ripe and fruity this un-oaked Chardonnay has notes of crisp citrus and ripe apple fruit on the palate followed by a refreshing finish.

Charquino Albarino 2015, Rias Baixas, Spain **£17.00**

Clean, fresh and intensely flavoured, the wine shows pineapple and passion fruit flavours, combined with citrus.

Clarence River Sauvignon Blanc 2015, Marlborough, New Zealand **£19.00**

A modern classic, this Marlborough Sauvignon has an intense elderflower aroma and complimentary flavours of crisp apple, grapefruit and gooseberry.

Gavi Guido Matteo 2015, Bosio, Piedmont, Italy **£19.50**

A wonderfully light and zippy white made from Italy's fragrant and delicate Cortese grape. With notes of green apple and zesty citrus in both the aromas and flavours.

Sancerre 'Les Blancs Gateaux' 2015, Domaine Tinel-Blondelet, Loire Valley, France **£27.00**

Classic Sancerre from one of the best producers in the Loire Valley. Bags of ripe, citrus and green fruit complemented by the trademark flinty minerality combine to produce a wine full in flavour that is gently, persistently refreshing.

Pouilly-Fuissé 2015, Les Grands Climats, Domaine de la Chapelle, Mâcon, France **£35.00**

This wine is scintillatingly good, with fabulous notes of baked apple, creamy vanilla and toasty oak. Rounded off and complemented by superb balance and excellent length.

Rosé Wines:

La Source Reserve Rosé 2016, Pays d'Oc, France **£12.00**

A deliciously pretty wine that has just the perfect balance of soft, ripe fruit and freshness, with notes of strawberry, raspberry and rose petal.

Red Wines:

Solano Tinto 2015, Galicia, Spain **£12.00**

The Solano Tinto is a blend of Tempranillo and Garnacha, spectacularly fresh yet warming, round, rich blackcurrants and black cherries and superbly smooth.

Rhanleigh Cabernet Sauvignon 2016, Robertson, South Africa **£12.50**

Packed with aromas of soft ripe blackberry fruit and an abundance of juicy plum flavours, finished with fine supple tannins and excellent structure.

Valcheta Malbec 2016, Mendoza, Argentina **£14.25**

A textbook Malbec from Mendoza, with youthful, ripe blackcurrant aromas and slight hints of dark chocolate flavours. It really is a very well balanced red wine with a spicy finish.

Monastrell 2014, Jumilla, Castillo de Jumilla, Spain **£14.25**

Deep purplish red, with flavours of mature fruit, cherries and blackberries, the Castillo de Jumilla is well balanced with a smooth mouthfeel and a pleasant sweetly spiced finish.

Montepulciano d'Abruzzo 2015, Moncaro, Italy **£14.25**

Wonderful black cherry and violet aromas with spicy notes to highlight the elegant oak. It's well rounded with a great finish resulting in a spectacular wine.

Sotherton Shiraz 2016, South East Australia **£14.00**

This has terrific depth, with rich, ripe, complex dark fruit and a touch of spice from the dominate Shiraz on the forefront. A subtle, aromatic lift on the finish from the small addition of Viognier.

Vaquero Unwooded Cabernet Sauvignon 2015, Lodi, California, USA **£15.50**

Delicious Californian Cabernet, with all the precision and polish for which the style is famous. Packed with ripe blackcurrant and brambly forest fruits.

Côtes du Rhône 'Les Combelles' 2015, Rhône Valley, France **£16.50**

Initial blackberry and cherry aromas with a hint of spice; develop wonderfully into fresh red currants, leather and a subtle earthy note. Finishing with delicate summer strawberries, this wine is elegantly balanced.

Tronido Crianza 2012, Rioja, Spain **£17.00**

Rich and punchy Rioja with spicy red cherries and a beautiful sweet vanilla note with all the liveliness of the dominant grape variety, Tempranillo – soft and well-structured, finished off with a delicious rounded mouth-feel.

Château Talaise 2014, Bordeaux, France **£17.00**

This terrific Bordeaux is very approachable and has delicious flavours of juicy strawberries and red cherry alongside a silky smooth body.

The Crusher 2014, Wilson Vale Pinot Noir, Clarksberg, California, USA **£22.00**

Mouth-wateringly ripe and a silky smooth texture, this Pinot Noir has aromas of cherry, raspberry and toasted cedar following to deliciously lush cranberry, summer berries, a faint hint of fennel with a touch of smokiness.

Querciavalle Chianti Classico 2011, Tuscany, Italy **£20.50**

This Chianti leads the way with its fleshy, bright red cherries, raspberries, ripe, well-rounded mouth-feel and toasty, polished finish.

Bourgogne Pinot Noir 2014, Chevillon Chezeaux, Burgundy, France **£30.50**

Delicate, refreshing and succulent Pinot Noir, full of pretty, ripe strawberries and raspberries. With supple a supple well rounded finish
